

Harvest Series (Part 1)
“What Kind of Harvest Are We Expecting?”

- I. **[SLIDE]** Today we are starting the Harvest series
 - a. **[SLIDE]** **Leviticus 26:3-5, 9-13 (NKJV)** **If you follow my decrees and are careful to obey my commands, 4 I will send you rain in its season, and the ground will yield its crops and the trees their fruit. 5 Your threshing will continue until grape harvest and the grape harvest will continue until planting, and you will eat all the food you want and live in safety in your land. ‘I will look on you with favor and make you fruitful and increase your numbers, and I will keep my covenant with you.**
 - b. **[SLIDE]** **10 You will still be eating last year’s harvest when you will have to move it out to make room for the new. 11 I will put my dwelling place among you, and I will not abhor you. 12 I will walk among you and be your God, and you will be my people. 13 I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt so that you would no longer be slaves to the Egyptians; I broke the bars of your yoke and enabled you to walk with heads held high.**
 - c. What a great passage about harvest.
 - i. In the OT, God’s idea of harvest for Israel was that they would still be eating last year’s harvest when it was time to start planting again for the next year’s harvest.
 - ii. Can somebody say, “Abundance?”
 - iii. God’s idea of harvest always involves abundance because God is not a stingy God. Never has been. Never will be.
- II. What kind of harvest are we expecting this month and for the remainder of the year?
 - a. I don’t know about you, but Pastor Willy & I have had a great year. Our business has prospered, the church has prospered, our civil government assignment has prospered, our children have prospered, our extended family has been blessed and prospered, and everything that we have touched this year has prospered. It has been an amazing year. However, the year is not over.
 - b. I feel like it is now time to turn our attention toward the harvest that has been prophesied.
 - c. **[SLIDE]** Let’s go back and review the word of the Lord that was given in the beginning of the year.
 - i. God said that it was activation time. He said that it would not be an outward, orderly activation, but a violent launching into a new orbit of Spirit-controlled, Spirit-filled atmosphere!
 - ii. He said that there had been much prayer saturation, but that now there would be holy fire ignition!
 - iii. He spoke of a torch that He had given us to set fire in four directions of Frisco, of revival fires that would spread quickly in all four directions.

- iv. He said that He was going to beam the light of His glory all over the North Texas region.
 - v. God said that He was moving into the neighborhood. He said that every bedroom community, town site, and rural area in the Dallas/Ft. Worth metropolitan region would feel the effects of the holy fire of His Spirit.
 - vi. God said that we were going to experience a holy shaking in North Texas, the likes of which has not been seen in this region since the '48 revival. He said the fall out would be great. New converts! Renewed Saints! New life!
 - vii. He said that we had sought Him for revival, and that He had heard our request, and He said that now our focus would be upon an abundant harvest fest!
 - viii. [SLIDE] He declared that those whom we had seen coming in the Spirit would now show up in the flesh!
 - ix. He said that we would no longer just be known for a training center, but a revival center to oversee new converts, families, youth, and children who would now call this their spiritual home.
 - x. He said that at first we would have to meet in their homes to be able to keep up with what He is doing! He said that these would be Holy Spirit baptismal meetings! As they invited their friends to attend these meetings, He would suddenly fall upon them in these home meetings as He did in New Testament times.
 - xi. He said that a strong spirit of prophecy would be present revealing the divine will and purpose He has for them! He declared that many who have been without employment for months, even years, will see openings for jobs take place!
 - xii. God said that He had seen our heart for government in the kingdom to be revealed to the Church, but now implementation of kingdom principles would be needed as He raised up His Church in the earth!
 - xiii. He said that this move of His Spirit would change the whole scenery around us as the new face of the Church was made visible before the eyes of religion and politics, which had merged together to form an occultism and not pure Christianity!
 - xiv. He said that the schools in our region would see what He is doing with the youth and that the youth will be outstanding! He said that parents will see the youth from our group and desire to bring theirs to be a part of such transformation in the region!
 - xv. Finally, He said there would be a merging of several groups who will want to join us. They have been meeting in homes all across the region! They have had no real headship to oversee their hunger and desire for revival, but will now see the need and come under our covering!
- d. As I went back and reviewed this prophetic word from Samuel Brassfield in light of what's happened in 2020, I can see that a lot of this word has been in motion this year, especially the parts about the violent launching, the holy fire ignition,

the holy shaking, people that we've see in the spirit realm showing up in the flesh, the new face of the church being made visible before the eyes of religion and politics, and now even the schools of the region starting to turn their eyes towards what we are doing with our young people.

- i. I can absolutely see this word in motion.
- ii. Some of the parts that I feel are right on the verge of manifesting have to do with the harvest part.
- iii. God said that He was moving into the neighborhood. He said that every bedroom community, town site, and rural area in the Dallas/Ft. Worth metropolitan region would feel the effects of the holy fire of His Spirit. He said that we would have to meet in homes to be able to keep up with what He is doing, and that as people invite their friends to attend these Holy Spirit baptismal meetings, He would suddenly fall upon them as He did in New Testament times.
- iv. I believe that we are yet to see this part of the prophetic word fully manifest, and that's where I want to set my faith for the remainder of this year.

III. [SLIDE] It is time for us to set our faith towards harvest.

- a. Honestly, harvest is all about expectation.
- b. **Expectation (def.)** – a strong belief that something will happen or be the case in the future; the act or state of expecting (anticipation).
- c. **Anticipation (def.)** – the act of looking forward; visualization of a future event or state; expecting that something will happen.
- d. Church, we are going to get what we expect in our life.
 - i. If we expect failure, we are going to get failure.
 - ii. If we expect defeat, we are going to get defeat.
 - iii. If we expect doom and gloom, we are going to get doom and gloom.
 - iv. But if we expect victory and success, we are going to get victory and success.
- e. [SLIDE] The Bible says in Mark 4:26-29, “²⁶And He said, “The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground, ²⁷ and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how. ²⁸ For the earth yields crops by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head. ²⁹ But when the grain ripens, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come.”
 - i. Are we able to see our progress by the eyes of the spirit?
 - ii. In the natural realm, a farmer can see his progress by simply looking at the development of the crop. He sees the blade, he sees the head, and then he sees when it is time to harvest the full grain.
 - iii. In the spiritual realm, however, it is not quite so easy. Sometimes we can't see what point we are at in the growing process, which is why we need the prophetic.
 - iv. The prophetic helps us see what we cannot see with our natural eyes of understanding.

- v. This is why prophetic words can be so helpful. They can help us see how far we've come, and how far we still have to go.
- vi. When I look at the Brassfield prophecy, I can see that KingdomLife has experienced the blade, and has experienced the head, but hasn't quite fully experienced the full grain in the head. But guess what? That's what's coming next! We are about to experience a harvest unlike we have ever seen in this church, and it is time to start expecting.

IV. [SLIDE] What are your expectations? Here are some of mine.

- a. I expect lost people to get saved.
- b. I expect people to be filled with the Holy Spirit.
- c. I expect young people to come to Christ unlike we have ever seen.
- d. I expect this place to be exploding with new life.
- e. I expect the gospel of the kingdom to spread from house to house and neighborhood to neighborhood.
- f. I expect the civil government to come under submission to the authority of Christ and His kingdom.
- g. [SLIDE] I expect a pillar of fire over this city and an open heaven over this region.
- h. I expect our worship to be the best worship in the world, and I expect people all over the world to come here and worship with us.
- i. I expect our children to prophesy. I expect our kids to lay hands on the sick and they recover. I expect our kids to be able to read people's mail, and prophesy their destiny as if they were an open book.
- j. I expect our youth to be on fire for God. I expect our young people to go into all the world and preach the gospel. I expect an outbreak of God across an entire young generation, and I expect a young generation to take our nation back for God.
- k. I expect this place to be filled and overflowing with spiritual fathers, spiritual mothers, sons and daughters, and I expect old men to dream dreams and young men to see visions.
- l. [SLIDE] I fully expect Joel 2:28 to manifest once again in our time. ***Then, after doing all those things, I will pour out my Spirit upon all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your old men will dream dreams, and your young men will see visions. In those days I will pour out my Spirit even on servants—men and women alike.***
- m. I expect the timed gate of Joel 2:28 to open once again on Dec 5, 2020. I expect a full revival. I expect a full outpouring of God. I expect an awakening. I expect a full reformation.
- n. [SLIDE] I expect Isaiah 2. ***In the last days, the mountain of the Lord's house will be the highest of all—the most important place on earth. It will be raised above the other hills, and people from all over the world will stream there to worship. People from many nations will come and say, Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of Jacob's God. There he will teach us his ways, and we will walk in his paths.***
- o. These are my expectations. What are yours?

- V. [SLIDE] What are you expecting from God the remainder of 2020?
 - a. Do you have a vision for your harvest?
 - b. Can you describe it?
 - c. Can you tell me what it looks like?
 - d. Can you tell me what it tastes like?
 - e. Can you tell me what it feels like?
 - f. What has God spoken over your life?
 - g. What has He said about your future?
 - h. Are you expecting that word to manifest?
 - i. This year? Next year? The year after that?
- VI. Whatever we expect for the remainder of this year is the harvest we are going to have so let's get our expectation right this year.
 - a. Let's sync up with God and get on the same page.
 - b. Let's get out of our flesh and out of the soul realm, and let's step into the spirit.
 - c. Let's see with eyes of the spirit what He wants to say and what He wants to do.
 - d. He is saying it is time for harvest, but the magnitude and the quality of our harvest is up to us to believe and receive.
 - e. If we can see it, we can receive it.
 - f. Let's ask for eyes to see this morning.
